

**CONTRACT BETWEEN VIRGINIA STATE LIBRARY BOARD  
and  
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF LIBRARY ACCEPTING SUPERVISORY SERVICE**

Pursuant to a revision in Section 42.1-52 of the *Code of Virginia* which states that, "In the event that any library meets the standards of the State Library Board but is unable to conform to Chapter 11 of Title 54 of the *Code* relating to the employment of certified librarians, the Library Board may, under a contractual agreement with such library, provide professional supervision of its services and may grant State Aid funds to it in reduced amounts under a uniform plan to be adopted by the State Library Board"; the following contract shall be in effect for one year beginning \_\_\_\_\_.

2. The party of the second part agrees to the following:
  - (a) When a certified professional librarian is not employed on its library staff, to accept the advice of a professional librarian designated by the Librarian of Virginia from the State Library's staff, on the same terms as such advice would be accepted from a professional member of its own staff, in the areas of collection building, arrangement of quarters and development of library routines.
  - (b) To provide adequate staff for the programs it undertakes.
