


## Emelia's Favorites!




[Darth Paper Strikes Back: An Origami Yoda Book](#) by Tom Angleberger




[The Difference Between You & Me](#) by Madeleine George




[Fangirl](#) by Rainbow Rowell






[Papertowns](#) by John Green




[Shiver](#) by Maggie Stiefvater (Series)




[Looking for Alaska](#) by John Green
