


If You Liked **Hunger Games** by Suzanne Collins Try....




[Blood Red Road](#) by Moira Young




[Divergent](#) by Veronica Roth (Series, Book 1)




[The Drowned Cities](#) by Paolo Bacigalupi




[The 5th Wave](#) by Rick Yancey




[The Giver](#) by Lois Lowry




[The House of the Scorpion](#) by Nancy Farmer




[Little Brother](#) by Cory Doctorow




[Looking Glass Wars](#) by Frank Beddor




[The Selection](#) by Kiera Cass




