




[13 Little Blue Envelopes](#) by Maureen Johnson




[17 First Kisses](#) by Rachael Allen




Girls Don't Fly by Kristen Chandler




He Said, She Said by Kwame Alexander




Love, Stargirl by Jerry Spinelli




The Infinite Moment of Us by Lauren Myracle




Sleepless by Cyn Balog




The Summer I Turned Pretty by Jenny Han
