

**When does the Summer Reading Program start?**

Registration begins Monday, May 23. The program begins Wednesday, June 1 and runs through Tuesday, July 26. You may register for the program up until Saturday, July 16.

**Does my child have to read material only from the library?**

No. Any material may be read by the child, or read aloud to the child. This includes magazine and newspaper articles, audiobooks and e-books.

**Do the logs have to be turned in on a particular day during the week?**

No, as long as the child has done the minimum required reading for the week in question (six chapters or six picture books).

**Can we turn in logs early?**

Once your child/children has/have completed six books or six chapters, you may turn in the log(s).

**When is the last day for turning in reading logs?**

Reading logs may be turned in until July 26. The last day to turn in logs to complete an entry in the grand prize drawing is Thursday, July 21. Reading logs turned in after that date will be eligible only for the weekly prizes. No logs can be accepted the day of the SRP Parties.

**We are going to be out of town for weeks at a time, can we still do the program?**

When you return from your trip, turn in the logs for those weeks.

**Can we turn in logs at another library (other than the one where we registered)?**

No. Logs must be turned in for prizes at the library at which they are registered. Participants may attend programs at any library.

**Can my infant and/or toddler participate?**

Yes, fill out the log with the books you have read to your child/children each week.

**Can I participate at all three branches?**

You may attend programs at any library, but you must turn in the logs at the branch in which you registered.
