

# Downloading ebooks with a NOOK color, Tablet, HD or HD+

With OverDrive you can download EPUB eBooks and MP3 audiobooks directly to your NOOK device.

## You will need:

A NOOK device with internet access

An Adobe ID (free account from [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com))

To read EPUB eBooks you will need to authorize your device with an Adobe ID. Visit [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com) and click “sign in” in the top right corner.

Create a free account. You will need this ID and password to authorize your NOOK device

Check your email and authorize your account before use.

## Overdrive Media Console App on your NOOK device

- Go to the app store on your device and download the free Overdrive app.
- The first time you download an EPUB book through your Overdrive app, you will need to enter your Adobe ID and password to authorize your device.

## How to Borrow titles to your NOOK.

1. Open your Overdrive Media Console App
2. Tap the Add a Library Button and search for the Guntersville Public Library
3. Enter your Guntersville Public Library card number with no spaces
3. Tap the book icon or the menu icon to find a book to borrow.
4. Tap a title, then tap BORROW to check it out. \*If the book is already checked out, you may see an option to place a hold on the title.
5. After you BORROW a title, your bookshelf opens, and displays the items you have checked out.
6. You can DOWNLOAD your eBook or mp3 audiobook by tapping the DOWNLOAD option. The book will then download. Once complete, tap the MENU icon and then BOOKSHELF icon to find your book. Tap on the title of the book to read it.
