

How to download eBooks with a NOOK

These instructions are for use with older generation NOOKs and the NOOK Simple Touch. Please see our other NOOK instructions for NOOK Color, Tablet, or HD.

What you will need

- The USB cable for your NOOK
- Adobe Digital Editions for your personal computer
- A valid Guntersville Library card

Install software

First, you will need to install Adobe Digital Editions (<http://www.adobe.com/solutions/ebook/digital-editions/download.html>) on your personal computer to transfer library eBooks to your NOOK. You will also need an Adobe ID to authorize your NOOK for use with library eBooks.

To register an adobe ID, visit www.adobe.com and click on “sign in” in the top right corner of the screen, then you can create an Adobe account. You will need this ID and password the first time you download a library eBook.

To browse, check out, and download titles to your computer

Open the Guntersville Library Overdrive page

<https://dmz.libraryreserve.com/10/50/en/SignIn2.htm?branchid=189&URL=MyBookshelf.htm%3f> and enter your library card number to sign in. You can browse and search through Overdrive. You can download an EPUB or PDF eBook.

Library eBooks will open in Adobe Digital Editions on your computer. You can transfer the eBook to your NOOK.
